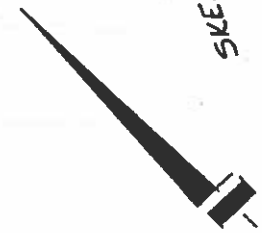

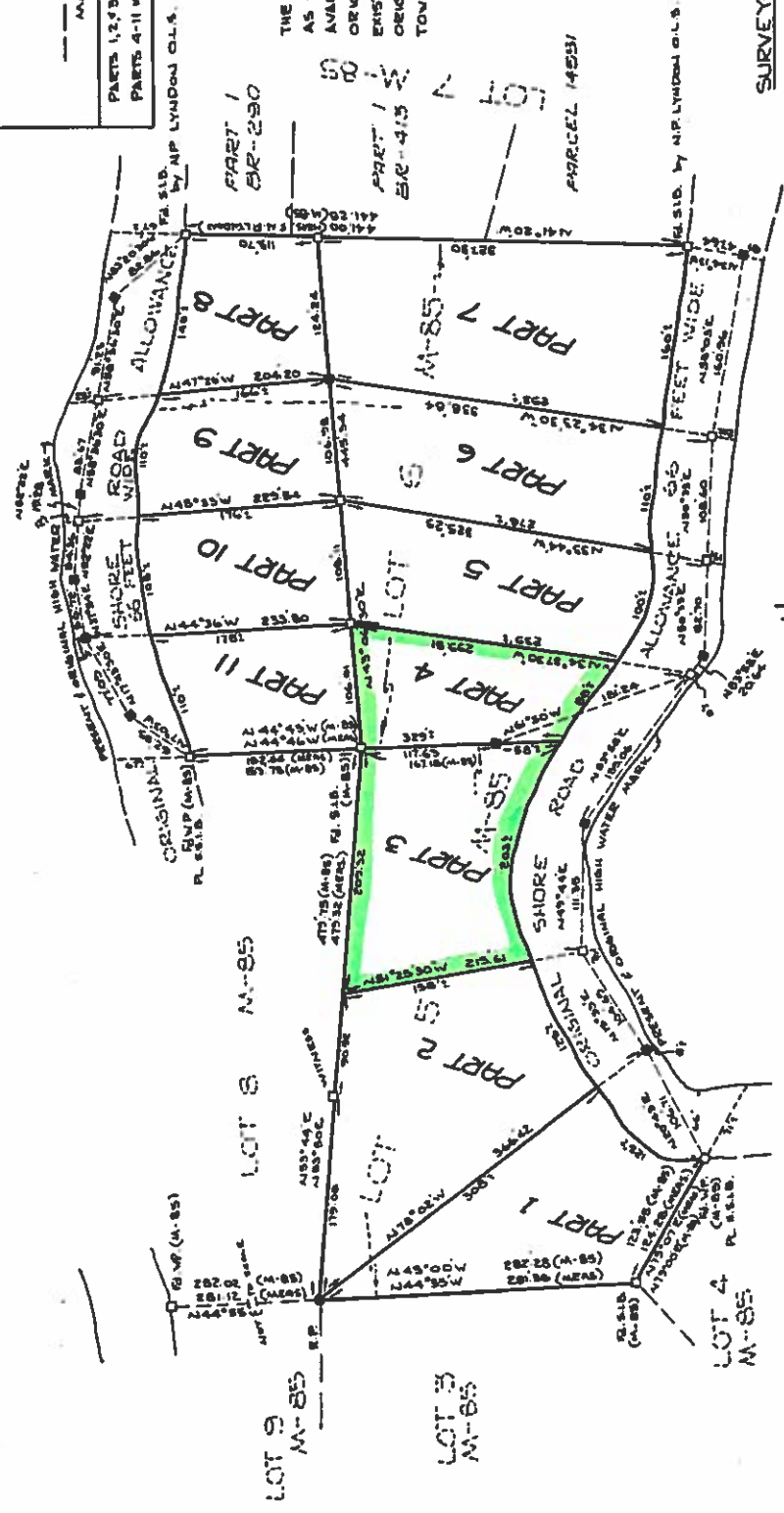
TOWNSHIP of CARDWELL
